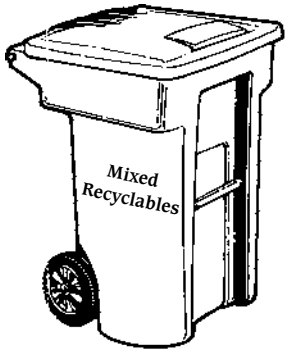


# CURBSIDE RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS	DO'S	DON'TS
<b>Aluminum Cans</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No cans used for paint or chemicals</li> </ul>
<b>Tin Cans</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No cans used for paint or chemicals</li> </ul>
<b>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No broken glass or window glass</li> <li>• No light bulbs, mirror or ceramics</li> </ul>
<b>Plastic Screw-Top Bottles with a Neck Smaller than its Base</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> <li>• Remove lids</li> <li>• Flatten or crush</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No plastic tubs, wrap, film, styrofoam, motor oil bottles or toxic bottles</li> </ul>
<b>Milk Cartons &amp; Drink Boxes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> <li>• Flatten or crush</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No frozen food or juice concentrate containers</li> </ul>
<b>Aerosol Cans</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Empty cans only</li> <li>• Throw Lids away</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No partial or full cans; these may be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste collection site</li> </ul>
<b>Newspaper</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Advertisements</li> <li>• Leave loose</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No plastic bags or rubber bands</li> <li>• No brown paper grocery bags with the newspaper</li> <li>• Don't bundle or tie</li> </ul>
<b>Mixed Paper</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Junk mail, magazines, phone books, paper bags, cereal and gift boxes and other clean paper</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No tissues, paper towels, napkins, paper plates or disposable diapers</li> <li>• No foil wrapping paper, pet food bags with plastic liners, or waxed paper liners as in cereal boxes</li> <li>• No frozen food or juice concentrate containers</li> </ul>
<b>Kitchen Scrap Metal</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No larger than 24" in any direction</li> <li>• Remove any attached plastic, wood or rubber</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No plastic, wood or rubber</li> <li>• No automobile parts</li> <li>• No loose nuts, bolts</li> </ul>
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flatten boxes</li> <li>• No larger than 3' x 3'</li> <li>• Cut down to appropriate size if larger than 3' x 3'</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No waxed cardboard</li> <li>• No food contaminated cardboard</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Oil &amp; Used Oil Filters</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pour into secure one gallon plastic milk jugs with a screw top lid</li> <li>• Place used oil filters in zip lock Bag</li> </ul> <p>Plastic Containers and oil filterbags can be provided by GWT free of charge</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do not mix oil with any other liquids</li> </ul>
MATERIALS	DO'S	DON'TS
<b>Leaves, Branches, Grass Clippings and Prunings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use your own 32-gallon cans for yard trimmings</li> <li>• "Yard Trimming Only" decal can be provided</li> <li>• For an additional fee per month a yard waste cart can be provided by GreenWaste of Tehama</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Weight cannot exceed 50lbs</li> <li>• Don't set out in plastic bags</li> <li>• No dirt, sod, or rocks</li> </ul>
