# Set Out Your Waste Properly

Please place your containers out the night before your service day, out at the curb where your driveway meets the street, at least six feet away from any nearby obstacles or vehicles. Carts placed away from the street or too close to other objects may not get picked up.



Reminder: street sweeping begins mid October 2016 and extends through the middle of May 2017. Please remember to move your vehicle the night before scheduled sweep day.



Only items placed in your recycling bin will be sorted for recycling. Trash is never sorted to recover recyclables - it is buried upon arrival at the landfill. Make sure you place your recyclables in your recycling bin!

# **New! Prescription Drug Disposal Kiosk**



Prescription drug disposal now available vear-round to Tehama County Residents, free of The kiosk charge. (pictured) is located in the lobby of the Tehama County Sheriff's Office at 22840 Antelope Blvd., Red Bluff. residents can drop off

prescription medication Monday through Friday 8AM-5PM. Having a regular disposal option for prescription drugs helps to keep them out of the hands of children or those who may abuse drugs, as well as protects our environment by keeping it out of our waterways. Solid pill and liquid medications, including controlled substances, can be disposed of in the kiosk. program is completely anonymous, no identification required and no forms to sign. # Free Battery and Cellphone Drop Off

- Round up unwanted household batteries and cellphones for recycling.
- Bag batteries and cellphones individually using bags provided at drop-off location or at home; or tape batteries using electrical tape.









Place bagged taped batteries & cellphones into the designated collection box.
